## Conditions and Hints

Intermediate and Novice entrants may stay in these sections until he/she feels comfortable in going to a higher section, keeping in mind once you go into a higher section you may not then exhibit in a lower section.

Wired Work is NON SECTIONAL i.e. neither OPEN, INTERMEDIATE or NOVICE, and is open to all entrants

You may enter in either OPEN and Wired Work, INTERMEDIATE and Wired Work or NOVICE and Wired Work.

For miniature arrangements please use small flowers (not large Cymbidium for example)

Embellishment means the adding of bows, ribbons or ornaments to decorate (if you wish). Gypsophila may be used as long as it is not the main flower in the arrangement.

NB: A Floral Art Handbook 'New Edition' is available as a helpful guide to Floral Art if required. Cost of this A5 size hardcover book is \$20.

Contact Helen Randall or you may view our handbook before entering, but please note this copy is not for loan.

## IMPORTANT

It is to be noted that at the first two shows (Autumn and Winter Show ONLY) Floral Art will now accommodate the use of other flowers in the arrangements.

The schedule will not be altered but you may add flowers other than orchids in your arrangements or use 'other' flowers only for your arrangement

eg: Class C: An arrangement using 1-5 orchids, you may now use a mix of flowers and orchids or just 'other' flowers in this arrangement. (Eg: 1-5 Roses)

Other classes will be interpreted in the same way.

The SPRING and SARCOCHILUS FESTIVAL will revert back to ORCHIDS ONLY
